Why do we do this?

Dear Church Family,

When I was a kid taking piano lessons, I learned the value of practice. I probably didn't learn it as quickly as my parents wanted me to (I remember hearing my mom ask quite a few times, "Why are we spending all this money on lessons if you won't practice?!"), but as I got older, I recognized that practice - the repetition of skills and phrases, often ad nauseum - allowed that music to become second nature to me. It lives deep in my muscle memory - to the point that I am still able to recall some pieces years later - almost two decades after I stopped taking lessons.

Perhaps you've played an instrument or a sport, or are accomplished at an art or trade. If so, you're probably well aware of the value of practice, and how repetition is key to those things becoming instinctive and natural.

When I talk with Confirmands about why we celebrate the Christian Year, this is the illustration I use. Our goal as Christians is to become like Christ. (Actually, that's what the word "Christian" means - we are "little Christs"!) We aim to live the way he lived and to love the way he loved - completely and sacrificially. This is not just something we do through pure will, but through years of practice and with the help of the Holy Spirit.

The Christian year invites us to walk with Jesus from His incarnation and birth, through the calling of His disciples, all the way to His death, resurrection and ascension. We repeat this year after year so that His story becomes a part of us and our lives take on the shape of His self-giving love. And because the Holy Spirit is a participant in our worship, God can do some pretty profound things in us. Over time, we'll find that loving like Jesus becomes easier - perhaps even second nature.

I want to invite you to join us over the next couple of days as we experience the final moments of Jesus' life: His last Supper with His disciples, His betrayal and arrest, and His crucifixion. It's in these moments that we remember the full extent of His love. Then on Easter Sunday, we'll celebrate the

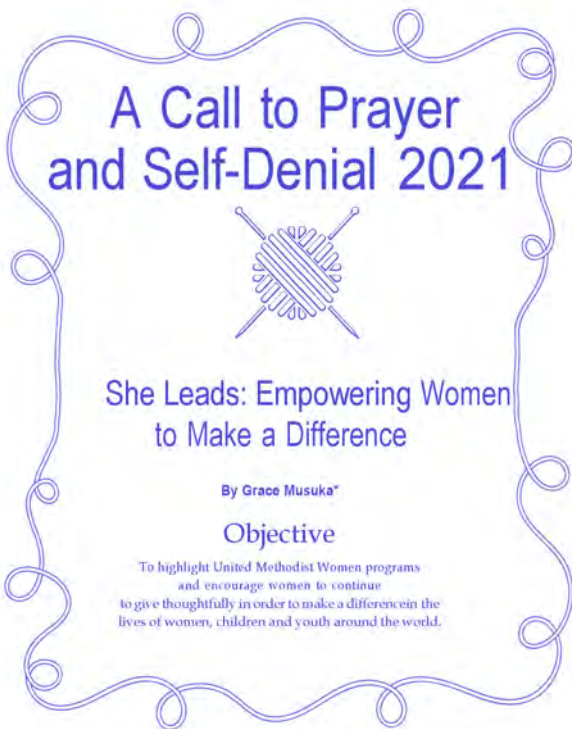
This offering will support programs that transform the lives of women, children and youth. When women are trained for transformation, good things follow:

SUNRISE SURPRISE

What you need:

- ½ cup chopped pecans
- 10 uncooked frozen rolls, thawed
- 10 large marshmallows
- ½ cup sugar
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- ½ cup melted butter
- ¼ cup brown sugar
- Adult help

What you do:

1. Grease a round baking dish. Sprinkle pecans on the bottom.
2. Flatten each roll. Place a marshmallow in the center, wrap dough around it and pinch edges together.
3. Combine sugar and cinnamon. Dip each roll into melted butter and coat with cinnamon-sugar. Place in pan, seam side down.
4. Sprinkle brown sugar and remaining butter over rolls. Cover with plastic wrap and let rise 30 minutes.
5. Bake at 350 degrees until golden brown, about 30 minutes. Cool in pan.
6. As you bite into a roll, you'll see the marshmallow has melted, leaving an empty center — just like Jesus' empty tomb!
