**Ezekiel 34:11-15 (CEB)**

<sup>11</sup> The Lord God proclaims: I myself will search for my flock and seek them out. <sup>12</sup> As a shepherd seeks out the flock when some in the flock have been scattered, so will I seek out my flock. I will rescue them from all the places where they were scattered during the time of clouds and thick darkness. <sup>13</sup> I will gather and lead them out from the countries and peoples, and I will bring them to their own fertile land.
