Dear RUMC Family,

Advent greetings to you and your loved ones! As we are preparing our hearts and homes to welcome Jesus, I've been pondering the Advent carol, *Lo, How a Rose E'er Blooming*. It's not one we sing much in church, but it's one I've come to love - particularly because it uses the image of a rose as a metaphor for the incarnation.

The incarnation - the act of God becoming human - is perhaps the single greatest mystery in the history of the world. In some branches of Christianity, it's even the tradition for the congregation to bow during the Nicene Creed when they recite the words, "[Jesus] was incarnate of the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary and became truly human" - out of reverence for this holiest moment in time.

The image of the rose captures at once both the beauty and fragility of the incarnation: the splendor of Almighty God wrapped in the vulnerability of human flesh. As I reflect on that juxtaposition, I can't help but think about the incredible risk it involved. God became a helpless infant, entrusting himself to the care of people like you and me. God risked rejection, suffering, and even death - all for our sake. And yet, that's what love looks like. Love always involves a measure of risk. It requires us to be vulnerable - to open ourselves to rejection, disappointment, heartache and grief. It's also the very thing we were made for.

As we prepare to welcome Jesus, part of what it looks like to embrace Him is to embrace this risky, all-in type of love. Doing that may push us out of our comfort zones, but I can't think of a better way to honor Jesus, whose love led Him to exchange the comfort of heaven for the struggles of earth. As we reflect on the mystery of His incarnation this Advent season, my prayer is that we would become a people who risk great love, and as we do, may we bring beauty to the world.


