Lighting the Advent Wreath

Today we light the fourth candle on our Advent wreath - a reminder that Jesus is almost here, and that Christmas comes whether we are ready for it or not. While that may cause some of us a small measure of alarm, it's actually quite a reassuring thing. It means that Jesus' coming isn't dependent on us - and it never was.

When the world was mired in sin, when the people of God had lost their way, Jesus came. Even though the circumstances weren't perfect and the setting was far from ideal, Jesus came.

He came not because of our readiness, or because of our deserving, but because God's relentless love cannot be stopped. And He comes each year, whether we are ready or not, whether we deserve Him or not.

We light this candle in joyful celebration of God's strong, unstoppable love.

At the end of the reading, all pray together:

Almighty God, even though our homes are not ready and our lives are not perfect, we ask that You would come make Your home among us once more. Help us to see that Christmas isn't dependent upon us at all, but upon Your unfailing love. And may the knowledge of that love reach the depths of our hearts and give us a joy that cannot be taken away. Amen.
