Dear RUMC Family,

We spent most of the month of January exploring what it means to live a mature, complete faith - using a model for discipleship inspired by our Methodist roots. As we considered how best to love God, we turned our attention to public worship, and the importance of prioritizing it in our weekly schedules. Then we explored how to nurture our love for God with personal acts of prayer, study and devotion. As we thought about how to love our neighbors, we were reminded that God works in our lives when we engage in acts of compassion. The earliest Methodists recognized this and regularly spent time ministering to prisoners, visiting the sick and the elderly, tutoring underprivileged children and caring for the poor.

Perhaps the dimension of discipleship that challenged us the most was that of justice - our work as Christians to close the gap between the Kingdom of Heaven and life here on earth. That's not because we don't believe justice is important, but because it is easy to find ourselves overwhelmed by the gulf between God's Kingdom vision and our reality. However, an important first step for us as followers of Jesus is to learn - to seek to understand the experience of others who suffer injustice in light of Jesus' teachings. This year, I pray that we'll be open to learning together.

During the month of February, we will be embarking on a four-week series based on the Negro spirituals - powerful songs that are the creation of African Americans who endured the brutality of slavery, often at the hands of Christian masters. This canon of music includes well-known hymns such as "Every Time I Feel the Spirit," "This Little Light of Mine," "There Is a Balm in Gilead," "Go Tell It on the Mountain," and "Were You There?", as well as countless others. Many have argued that the spirituals are America's greatest contribution to the church's collection of sacred music. I hope that you'll join us - whether in person or online - to learn from the stories and faith of those who have brought them to us.

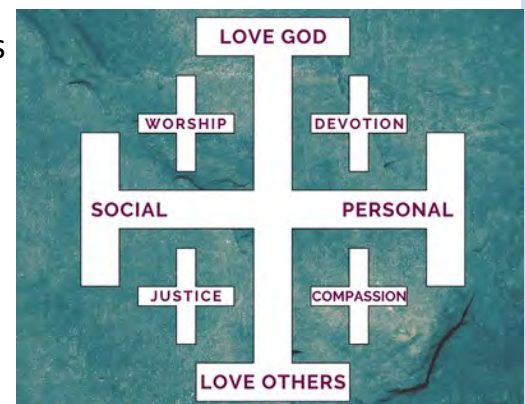

Author Leo Buscaglia, who became known as “Dr. Love” for writing about the topic, said, “Too often we underestimate the power of a touch, a smile, a kind word, a listening ear, an honest compliment or the smallest act of caring, all of which have the potential to turn a life around.”

Golden GIVING

What you do:

2. Write notes or draw pictures for recipients, placing one in each bag.
3. Zip bags and keep them in a vehicle to distribute. Or deliver them right away to people in need (or to sick or homebound people, nursing home residents, a homeless shelter and so on).
4. Pray that God will use your gifts to help and encourage each recipient.
