### Our Mission: Growing Together in Christ Through Worship, Fellowship, Witness and Service

Dear friends,

Perhaps you learned somewhere in your study of U.S. history that Thomas Jefferson created his own version of the New Testament. While it's most commonly referred to as the *Jefferson Bible*, the actual title of the manuscript was *The Life and Morals of Jesus of Nazareth*. Taking a razor and glue, Jefferson cut and pasted selections from the four Gospels, omitting all references to the supernatural and to Jesus' divinity. In Jefferson's Bible, there are no miracles and no resurrection.

While Jefferson appreciated Jesus' exemplary life and teachings, his rational worldview didn't allow any space for the miraculous. My initial reaction to this history lesson many years ago was, "How presumptuous do you have to be to *edit* the Gospels?" But as I've spent more time preaching and teaching the Gospel message, I've realized that I've tended to steer away from many of Jesus' miracles, too. Not all of them, of course, because we've tackled Jesus calming the storm and walking on water in recent months. However, every time we open our Bibles to look at one of these miracle stories, I'm aware of the hurdles that exist for some of us – questions like, "Did this really happen? And if it did, is there a more reasonable explanation?"

Debates like that actually distract us from some of the best lessons in these stories. Whether we believe in modern-day miracles or not, the people of Jesus' day were at home with the thought that some things simply defy the laws of nature. For them, the fact that there was a miracle was much less the point than what it signified – the message it communicated about Jesus, about the world, and about the recipient(s) of the miracle.

Starting September 11, I invite you to join us for a new series, *Miraculous: Finding Meaning in the Miracles of Jesus*. We'll get some help from Amy-Jill Levine, a Jewish scholar of the New Testament, who has done some very thoughtful work about how 1<sup>st</sup> century Jewish people would have experienced and interpreted Jesus' signs and wonders. September 11 also marks the start of a new Sunday School year, so if you have kids or grandkids who are Sunday School age, be on the lookout for news about Sunday School registration and programming. I hope you can join us, whether in person or online!
