Wesley Chapel By Laws

1869. By Laws of the Trustees "Wesley Chapel"

March 25th.

" Whereas in all well regulated bodies, to secure harmony
" in their acts, by laws are essential.

" And whereas by an act of the General
" Assembly of Maryland passed March 4th - 13th 1867 did incorporate
" as a body Politic the following named persons as trustees of "Wesley
" Chapel, Episcopal Methodist Church (south) at Reisterstown Baltimore
" County - William Devoyer - Johnsey Gardner - Jeptha S. Bennett.
" Thomas K. Haughey - Elias C. Stockdale - John H. Gore - Daniel
" B. Banks and Andrew Banks - and by the same name to have
" perpetual succession, and be able and capable to sue and be sued
" implead and be impleaded in any court of law or equity in this
" State or else where, and to make and have a common Seal, and the
" same to break alter or renew at pleasure - And the said members
" did then and there agree upon the plan of perpetuating the succession
" of said trustees, and of ascertaining the proper qualifications
" and establish the Articles or plan herein after mentioned
" So Wit - Sec^t 1st Whenever a Vacancy or Vacancies shall happen
" by death resignation, removal or ceasing to be a member of the
" Episcopal Methodist Church (southern) according to the rules and
" discipline of said church - Then and in such case it shall be the
" duty of the stationed Minister or Preacher in charge who shall have
" the pastoral oversight as aforesaid to call a meeting of the remaining
" trustees as conveniently as may be and when so met - the Minister or
" Preacher shall proceed to nominate one or more person or persons
" to fill the place or places of him or them, whose office or offices has or have
" been Vacated as aforesaid - And the said trustees so assembled
" shall proceed to elect and by a Majority of Votes appoint the person or persons
" so nominated to fill such Vacancy or Vacancies in Order to keep up the
" Number of eight (8) Trustees forever -
